## Cell-Loc technology now used in Sao Paulo

Cell-Loc Location Technologies Inc., which recently completed the commercial rollout of its wireless location network in Sao Paulo, Brazil, said Wednesday the network is now being used to assist in the recovery of stolen vehicles.

The Calgary-based firm's Brazilian subsidiary, **X3 Telecomunicacoes e Equipamentos**, has established installation sites throughout Sao Paulo, providing it with a capacity of approximately 4,500 vehicles per month.

To date, X3 technology has assisted in the recovery of 22 vehicles, the company said in a release.

"X3 continues to increase the number of beacons installed in vehicles insured by its customer, **Itau Seguros**," it added. "The company expects installations to exceed 3,750 vehicles per month during the fourth quarter."
